We use them to look up the meaning of a word or find words with similar meanings. These are important tools for understanding language. They can also help you determine the parts of speech a word belongs to and whether a word is considered formal or informal. Dictionaries are usually arranged in alphabetical order. They can be used to sort words by their starting letter or by the number of letters in each word. They are also commonly known as word books or lexicons.
