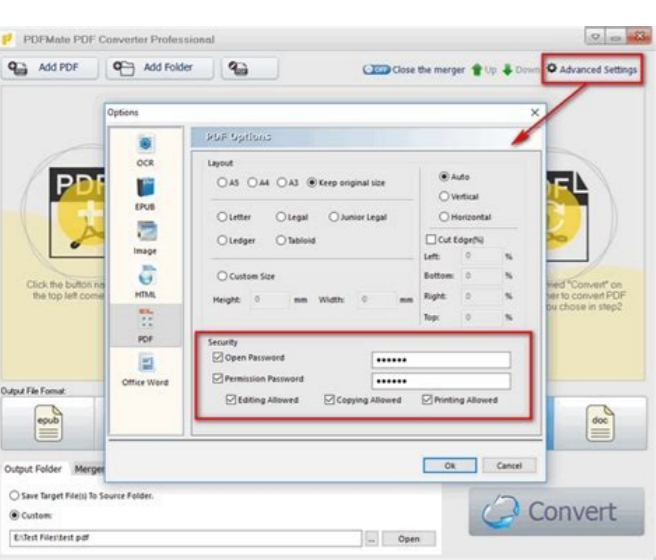
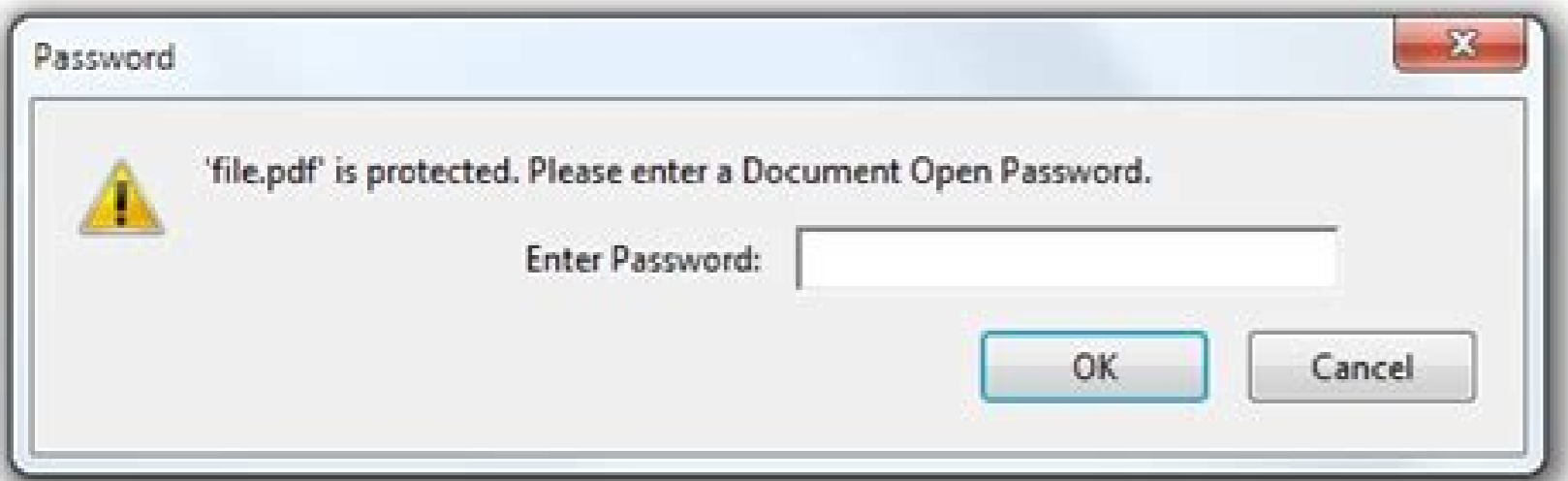
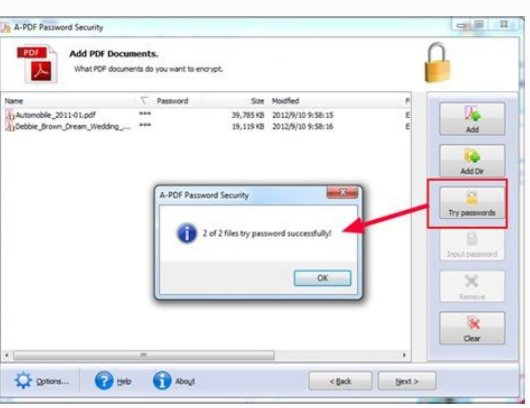

Press Ctrl+P or click the "Print" button, then make sure that "Print to PDF", "Save to PDF" or something similar is selected as the printing device. You can also use Adobe Acrobat Pro to remove PDF password. Some PDF files are encrypted with a password that you must enter every time you want to view the document. When you save the PDF file, you can remove the password to avoid any inconvenience safe place. Handy Trick: Print to PDF RELATED: Print to PDF on Any Computer, Smartphone or Tablet It might sound a little silly, but you can easily and conveniently remove the password from a PDF file by opening it and printing it out in a new PDF file. Your system creates a duplicate of the PDF file and this duplicate has no password. This trick only works if the PDF file has no printing restrictions. However, many PDF files are simply password protected for encryption and can be printed as normal after entering the password. This can be done in several ways. If you're using Chrome on Windows, macOS, Linux, or Chrome OS, you can do it right in your browser. First, open the PDF document and enter the required password. When viewing a password-protected document, click the Print button on the PDF toolbar. Under Destination, click the Edit button and choose Save as PDF. Click the Save button and you will be prompted for a name and location for the new PDF file. Your new PDF file contains the same content as the original PDF file, but is not password protected. This method works in Chrome on any operating system, but you can do the same trick with other apps and PDF printers. For example, Windows 10 has a PDF printer, which means you can do this in Microsoft Edge or any other Windows PDF viewer. When prompted, enter a name and location for the new PDF file. The new PDF file will have the same content as the original, but will not contain the password. Note. Due to the printing process, the resulting PDF file will not have selectable text. If you want to copy text from a pdf file, you need to reopen the original password-protected pdf file and copy the text from there. You can also use optical character recognition (OCR) software for an unprotected PDF file. Official Method: Use Adobe Acrobat Pro You can also do it the official way using the paid Adobe Acrobat Pro application. This program is different from the free Adobe Acrobat Reader PDF viewer that is available to most people. Adobe offers a one-week free trial of Acrobat Pro. Adobe Acrobat Pro will work even if the PDF file has print restrictions and cannot be printed in other applications using the above trick. Open the PDF file in Adobe Acrobat Pro and enter the password to view it. Click the lock icon on the left side of the window, then click "Permission Information." Alternatively, click File > Properties and the Security tab. Click the "Security Method" box, select "No Security" and click "OK" to remove the password. Click File > Save to save your changes. Alternatively, you can simply close the Adobe Acrobat Pro DC 1 window you will be prompted to save your changes. Once you do this, the password will be removed from the original PDF file.
