The game is set in a modern environment and allows the player to play as both a cop and a gangster at different times in a cops and robbers style game. The game can be played online with up to 16 players using a network card on PS2 and Xbox Live on Microsoft Xbox, as well as the Windows version. With the purchase of the Windows version, customers also received a free "Street Warriors" game card, which featured a character from the game itself. These playing cards were exclusive when they were only included in the PC copies. The game tells the story of a man named Freeze, his friend Sean Calderon and the policeLester Williams in the fictional town of Las Ruins. Freeze commits crimes with Sean to get money for his family while Williams tries to stop organized crime and the whole city. One evening after he returns home, his wife tells him about these activities. She says they are a bad influence on her son and wants him to stop. After an argument, he agrees. The next day, he tells Sean that he wants to quit the game. Sean flattens Frieza at gunpoint and informs him that he has one last assignment, which is drug dealing. After the deal, Freeze finds the Colombian gang members dead and waiting cop Maria Mendoza. Freeze escapes with the police and loses them. The 2nd Street D-Boys realize that Freeze wants out of the gang and must avoid both his former gang and the police. He later robs a bank. After a shootout with the police, he makes it to his getaway car, but is arrested after being hit with a baton. Meanwhile, Mendoza briefs Williams on Sean. They look for Sean at his house but get caught in a shootout. Williams finds clues and goes to the club to find Sean and chases him to the subway. The chase ends with Williams apprehending Sean, but Mendoza kills him and tells Sean to go to Mexico. Sean goes to Tijuana and plays for the local club The Curtains Club. He robs a casino, fights security and goes to a rich man named Zaragoza in his penthouse, whom he kills. Freeze escapes from prison and buys new clothes at the mall while being pursued by the police. He kills Mendoza at the mall and tracks down Sean, now a wealthy drug lord, eventually kicking Sean in the neck until he chokes to death. The final scene shows Freeze telling Darnell, "It's just you and me against the world from now on. Now let's do it" as a large crowd of cops arrive and Freeze takes a gun and points it at the police. History The band was formed by Frank Smarra (bass) and Harry Minas (drums) in Astoria, Queens, New York. They were soon joined by Fred Mesk (guitar) and together wrote most of the material that would appear on their early releases. In early 1992, they hired ex-Agnostic Front technician Rick Healy to add lyrics to all the songs. They adopted the name after being suggested by Freddie Krischen of Madball, who also helped them by giving them guest appearances at the end of their sets. 25 ta Life played their first full show at Studio 1 in New Jersey on May 10, 1993, supporting Obituary. After several failed attempts to add a second guitarist, Steve Pettit (formerly of Dmize) joined the band in late 1993. In January 1994, bassist and founding member Frank left the band due to family reasons and was replaced by Warren Lee. from Out of Line Queens.
