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Coffee has been used to factory test the appliance and it is therefore completely normal for there to be traces of coffee in the mill. The grinding coarseness regulator should only be turned when the coffee mill is on. The grinding coarseness regulator must only be turned when the coffee mill is on. Turn counterclockwise to obtain finer ground coffee, slower delivery and a creamier appearance. Turn clockwise for coarser ground coffee and faster delivery not a drop at a time. To obtain a creamier froth, dip the cappuccino frother into the milk and rotate the container with slow movements from the bottom upwards. Prepare the coffee as described previously, using large enough cups, then fill with the frothed milk prepared previously. Sweeten to taste and, if desired, sprinkle the froth with a little cocoa powder. **IMPORTANT** To guarantee cleanliness, you are recommended to follow this procedure each time you make cappuccino to avoid milk stagnating in the cappuccino nozzle. Before performing any cleaning operations, leave the appliance to cool down and unplug from the outlet. Do not use solvents or abrasive cleaning products to clean the appliance.
