I tried feeding these humidifiers with both hard water, and soft water, each fouled the pads. I was apprehensive when I ordered your humidifier. When I received it, I was very impressed with the quality and design. Installation was easy, and it has run without maintenance for 4 months, and still looks new. I also installed and highly recommend the AutoFlush3 unit, which I am convinced has a lot to do with how clean the humidifier still is. If your home is larger than these sizes, or has multiple furnaces then you may need to order more than one unit.As long as your furnace has a fan or blower and blows warm air through ducts out to your home, the desert spring will work for you. This includes forced air heat pumps.In most cases the homeowner can do it themselves if they are handy. If you decide that youd like to hire someone to do the installation for you, any general handyman or HVAC professional can do it. If youd like to get an idea of what the installation entails, check out our online installation guide Where can I get another one This is done by closing the needle valve. The water should be drained out of the unit and the damper on the hot air duct should be closed. Once all the water has been drained it is often a good idea to clean out any minerals that may have settled in the basin or on the disc wheel. A vinegar and water solution works well for this. The final step is to turn the humidistat down to its lowest setting which will effectively turn off the power to the humidifier. If you purchase our extra value package or ultimate value package this is increased to two 2 years. If your water supply is very hard, then you may have to clean out your Desert Spring furnace humidifier

Installation requires some tools, measurement, attention to detail, etc. Im not really handy but actually enjoyed this project great instructions. Worked very well last winter. I installed it myself, with better guality ducting than provided by the manufacturer. I had a humidistat in the living room that I used to control the humidifier. I wired the humidifier to the the 24volt furnace blower switch so the humidifier only ran when the furnace was on. That house was a 1,900 sq ft trilevel, with forced hotair heat and was extremely well insulated. The Desert Spring did an excellent job of maintaining the humidity during Wisconsin winters at 40%, our target. The autoflush pump had a hard time dealing with the calcium flakes that would slough off the disc wheels, and I had to clean it about once a month. We moved in 2004 to a 3,500 sq ft 2story house in the country, with its own well. The forced hotair heat furnace also had central airconditioning. After our first winter there, I installed another Desert Spring humidifier to counter the dry air and static electricity problem we had. Again, I installed a water line to a nonsoftened water supply.

The well water was not very hard anyway, but a softener was installed by the previous owner. Since the water was not hard, I did not install an autoflush. Instead I briefly installed an Gardena 1030 automatic watering timer. I found it wouldnt work without water pressure there is no water pressure in the humidifier basin, so I took the watering timer off and just manually opened the plastic hose valve I installed on the humidifier basin drain for a halfhour every other day. Since we were in the basement daily, it was not an inconvenience. This time we used the inreturn air duct humidistat provided by Desert Spring, and adjusted it for winter temperatures as needed. Again, the Desert Spring did an excellent job of maintaining the humidity during Wisconsin winters at 40% or more. In fact, in that house we had some trouble with condensation on the windows. We moved to our current 2,950 sq ft, 1 story, country house in 2010. One of the first things I did was install a Desert Springs DS3200 humidifier on the forced hotair furnace, again using semirigid expandable aluminum duct instead of the flimsy silverplastic ducting supplied with the humidifier. The furnace had a 24volt humidifier connection built in making the wiring simple. I used the saddlevalve supplied to connect the humidifier to a nonsoftened water supply pipe. I have found a nopressure automatic drain valve timer, the Gilmour 9500 electric watering timer, that works very well. This time we used the inreturn duct humidistat provided by Desert Spring, and adjusted it for winter temperatures as needed. I will be installing the outsidetemperatureregulatedhumidistat that we purchased from Desert Spring. Again, the Desert Spring does an excellent job of maintaining the humidity during Wisconsin winters at 40% or more. In fact, in this house we have some trouble with inside condensation on the windows. Hopefully the new outsidetemperatureregulatedhumidistat will resolve that.

If you have any doubts, consult a professional.It has worked now for at least 10 years. I do have autoflush installed but it does not stop the orange mold building up.If I miss it then there is buildup

and I have to pull the wheel and soak it in bleach solution and maybe vinegar, too, to take any mineral buildup off it. I have to soak the basin as well to kill the mold in there. Its a mystery where this stuff comes from.I have a 2800 sq ft house and the Desert Spring keeps the humidity at 30% all winter. If the outside temp is below 0 degrees F, the humidity should be less than 25%. If its around 30 it should be around 3035%. So here in Colorado we needed something to get the humidity in the house above 20% and keep us from shocking ourselves on doors, each other, electronics, etc. This humidifier does all that. If youre trying to get your humidity over 40% youre going to have condensation and other issues mold in your house in the winter. I dont think anyone would suggest going over 40%. So, if youre ok with humidity around 30% which is perfectly comfortable to us then this is a great unit. I installed mine 8 winters ago now and it works great. Id say 8 years is pretty good with no problems! In fact, that is pretty much the only thing that can go wrong with this unit, so if you want a low cost unit this really is it. I have a model with an automatic hygrometer that will stop the motor when it reaches the humidity you set, but I just crank it up to 40% and it continually runs all winter. I did get the automatic drain after getting tired of doing it manually. You really should drain it and let it fill with clean water ever week, the automatic drainer does it every 2 days. I could see having some issue with really hard water, but the buildup isnt too bad here, though again, it drains every 2 days so that probably helps. I wash it out at the end of the winter and its ready for the next year. It made a definate improvement in the humidity of my house.

Though my house is only about 1800 sq feet it kept it right at 40% humidity. Before I installed it my skin was always dry and we had to have the temperature up a little higher to feel comfortable. My only complaint is how it mounts to the cold air return. It basically hangs on the side of the cold air return plenumn. Somewhat unstable but certainly works. This is the only reason it only gets 4 stars. Update After almost three years of use. Its still working great. Only on the very coldest and driest winter days will it struggle to keep the house at 40% humidity using gas heat and sometimes our fireplace. Other than that, it works perfectly. Just remember to drain it every 23 days. Or buy one of the automatic drainer attachments.
