The basics as far as you need for transport are how to split the column from the base. This has to be done with care or the focus chains come of their gears and its a fiddly messy job to relocate them, due to the grease. There are two bolts at the rear which need screwing in to lock the gears before you remove the front parts. First remove the head but watch the spring that counter balances it must be tightened down or the head shoots straight to the top of the column. The floor standing base is unlikely to fit in most cars, I needed to hire a van. The baseboard can be removed but the frame is still quite large. IanI managed to transport the beast in the back of a Renault Laguna, but to do it in a car may need the baseboard support removing, which will leave the control handles dangling a bit precariously. Moving a De Vere 504. We took a transit van in the end and lay it down to save taking it to bits. I now need some advice on how the neg carrier goes together but I will do a new post for this. To start viewing messages, Does anyone have instructions on disassembly so I can fit it into my friends truck ThanksI remember seeing a thread about disassembling a Devere for transport on there. I can tell you from experience that if you are going to mess with the head at all make sure you lock down the two knobs at the base of the column it can be a jawbreaker! Head is easy to remove but either make sure the neg stage is at the top of the column or its secured properly to the base of the column I used web cam straps to do this. That thing will clock you good if you let it fly up when the head is taken off. Otherewise the stage shoots up the columns the counter weight springs are strong and you could do spme serious damage or get injured badly. 2 Theres bolts on the back of the base unit that need fully tightening up to hold the chain gears in place, if you fail to do this properly its a very messy fiffly job getting them back ion place. I did scan the sections in manual but not sure I can find them quickly IanAnyway, a snowstorm has prevented me from picking it up today, but Ill go and have look see for disassembly purposes.

Thanks again! The column should unbolt easily though on the bench model its the same on both versions. IanIt should however fit in a truck with the head taken off. If space is an issue, remove the baseboard from the bottom assembly and leave the column attached. Included with the enlarger is a 4x5 mixing chamber, and several negative carriers. I have 35mm, 6x6, 6x7, and a strangelooking bit of metal; it has what looks like a 6x9 or 6x12 cutout with rounded corners, but it is much thicker and somewhat smaller than the other carriers. Anybody know what this is. And if anyone has a spare 4x5 and 645 carrier, Id love to hear from you; I also need two lensboards, not sure what the lensboards look like. Thanks again. This is probably the most advanced enlarger head ever made, it was designed and produced in the USA and sold as the Sentinel enlarger which cost upwards of 20 thousand dollars at the time. ZBE also supplied the head to De Vere and Durst to use on their chassis, the head is rare because it was very expensive at the time. ZBE made the closed loop system for the De Vere enlargers, the keyboard is very similar in design, the exception is that this enlarger head apparently can compensate between changing black and white multi contrast grades. The enlarger uses three 300 watt 24 volt bulbs and has a timed shutter for correct exposure, no stabiliser of transformer is required, just use a kettle lead to the mains. I have not used it for printing black and white but have used it for colour printing. The head is in good condition and shows little signs of use, comes with De Vere 504 mounting kit but can be used on other enlargers. Comes with 5x5 mixing box with the 900 watt power output does not need any other box De Vere 504 head mounting kit, but no bulbs as they will probably break in transit, comes with digital backlit keyboard with flexible cable and kettle lead.

The head is in good condition, does have some white substance on it not sure if it was a sticky label or paint, see pictures. I have 2 PDF manuals for this one ZBE and one for Durst enlargers, they show all function of the enlarger. I will answer any questions to my best ability and I can attache a PDF manual to the reply if need be You are the light of the world.
