The combination of pitch and phase modulation can be used together or individually for traditional chorus sounds or unique, spatial tones. The guitar used is a new American 70's Strat, info the Halo Chorus, then left channel out to a Fender Custom Shop Vibroverb reissue and right channel to a Marshall 1974x reissue. The sample starts with a stereo recording of the two dry amps, then the Halo switches in for the remainder of the sample. This sample used a Tele into the Halo into a silver face Fender Princeton Reverb and the Marshall 1974x reissue. This sample has the Halo on throughout its duration. The Halo Chorus features a pitch modulation as well as a phase modulation effect due to it's dual path design. Each effect can be controlled individually via the Pm and Ch mix knobs. This allows the Halo Chorus to be capable of all kinds of crazy swirling madness. The Diamond Halo Chorus features an NOS BucketBrigade MN3007 chip that operates at 15v for extended headroom and clarity, premium Panasonic Capacitors and BurrBrown opamps, and truebypass switching for pristine signal path with the effect on or off. The Diamond Halo Chorus also features stereo operation for room spinning chorus and phase this feature is really fun with drunk people. The Diamond Halo Chorus also features an expression jack that gives the option of foot controlled modulation for rotary speaker style effects. The Diamond Halo Chorus provides some of the smoothest modulation of any pedal on the market. The full frequency response yields full, even chorus that doesn't sound thin or raspy. The Halo Chorus phaser function is funky and cool with super rich tone. When both are blended together there is some excellent spatial psychedelia that can be had. The Diamond Halo Chorus also features a killdry switch that allows for use in a parallel effects loop or you can use the chorus path for vibrato. UTILIZATION Users of the Diamond Pedals Halo Chorus shouldnt have any problems using it, as everything is pretty straight forward here. For parameters, youve got chorus depth, speed, phase modulation mix, and chorus mix. If used, an expression pedal can also control delay time and LFO. After playing with the pedal for a short while I was able to understand the pedal fairly well, so I cant imagine too many people having difficulties understanding it. Ive never had a need to look at the manual for the Hal Chorus pedal. SOUND QUALITY The sounds that are possible with the Diamond Pedals Halo Chorus go way beyond just your standard chorus sounds. It also has delay and phase like tones, the combination of which makes for an awesome sounding modulation pedal. While it is certainly possible to get traditional sounding chorus tones, I think that this pedal makes its living on its unique tones, as this sounds unlike most pedals that Ive used out there. Ive used the Halo Chorus with a Fender Telecaster and a 65 Fender Deluxe Reverb, so I definitely got an accurate read on what the pedal truly sounds like, and let me tell you that you can really get some interesting sounds with this one. This isnt to discredit the more traditional chorus tones that are possible, as they are extremely clean sounding as well. OVERALL OPINION While more expensive than most chorus pedals out there, Diamond Pedals Halo Chorus isnt your typically chorus pedal at all. It has unique parameters and unique sounds to match, as well as more traditional ones. The pedal is built extremely well and is one that should last a long time if treated properly.

SOUND QUALITY This is the best chorus pedal I have ever heard. The analog man chorus is really awesome, but like the Olympics, when you have things this good, one is only a little better than the other. In this case it's the Diamond. This is a guitar effect, but I use this on both guitars and my Fender Rhodes. Very versatile! OVERALL OPINION I have had this pedal for 1 year. My only complaint besides the two internal switches not being external not that big of a deal really is the very loose fitting of the AC plugs cable into the back of the pedal. It has been pulled out twice during gigs causing me to lose my signal. Kinda lame. I owned a Boss Super Chorus first, and a Line 6 Pod also, which neither of these compared not even close. But I did my research on this pedal and found reviews and audio samples and tried a few other high-end pedals. This was indeed the sweetest. Since the seller told me he had the original power supply, I will ask for help here before contacting the seller could any Halo owner here post a pic of its power adaptor, or at least transcript what is written on its label. Thanks in advance! If I remember correctly, it's 12 volt and center positive. Yours doesn't even look close and is the wrong voltage. Hope that helps. I can't wait until when I can plug into it and hear what it sounds like. I ordered one in a custom colour. Just pointing out that maybe there are factory supply changes going on. Before coming here to ask, I did a Google search and took a look at some ads at Reverb and eBay. I didn't find any adapters similar to mine, but I noticed not all of them seemed to be the Diamond model. Thanks again! We've used a few different supplies over the years depending on availability. Mostly CUI including the Diamond branded supplies but also Triad. Because all the high voltage pedals were designed for 18/24V sometimes they come with 18V and sometimes with 24V,

again depending on what was available at the time. Because the voltages are regulated internally, there's no sound difference between the 18V and 24V power supplies. It definitely caused a bit of confusion over the years. We've used a few different supplies over the years depending on availability. It definitely caused a bit of confusion over the years. I posted this question here and right after sent an email to Diamond with virtually the same text on it. I was more than satisfied because I had my question answered pretty soon here. And now I've just received a TGP alert and then I find out that Diamond itself came to help! I can't wait until when I can plug into it and hear what it sounds like. I've gigged each one extensively, and I like to tell people that I ride 'em hard, and put 'em away wet. Other than a bit of minor oxidation on the exterior nickel-plated washers, my Diamond pedals still look brand spankin' new. I think this is due to the exceptionally tough powdercoated finish, which seems to be second to none in durability and appearance. The only repair I've had to do was to replace the bypass foot switch in my ML2, because I literally wore it out from stepping on it thousands of times.

Fortunately, I'm handy with a soldering iron, and was able to replace it myself. One look inside the pedals told me that Diamond doesn't skimp on electronic design, or component quality. It's topnotch throughout. I think you will like the Halo. It's a great-sounding take on an analog chorus with the option to blend in a phaser. You should upgrade or use an alternative browser. I need a stereo output, real stereo, not wet-dry as in the 234. The Cs9 vintage 84 is great but has no level control. Mxr 234 is mono and it has good sounds but horrible buffer tone sucker, dropped. Corona is honest but lacks on stereo separation to me. So I went considering MXR 134 but after the 234 and the mxr ILTORINO with a nasty 100hz native defect I will never more buy MXR. The Cr7 is very good indeed and for me it is now the only choice. I am considering something else to be used only on clean sounds and stereo Diamond and Strymon. The Halo being analog the Strymon being digital, no problems. What is best, not considering price. I dropped Red Witch both Empress and the other after reading tons of complaints and tons of offers on the 2nd hand market. I'd really appreciate some concerned opinions here. However, I have owned the Diamond Halo, and it's the one pedal that I truly regret selling. In my experience it absolutely excels for clean sounds, and in stereo, but not in the traditional sense. That's because one side of the stereo signal path provides short delay plus pitch modulation, while the other side provides phase modulation. Essentially, the Halo is a chorus and a phase pedal running in parallel, with their LFOs synchronized. While you don't have individual speed rate control over the chorus and phase, you do have control over the individual depth of each effect. Amongst other things, this gives you the option of lowering the chorus depth control to zero, enabling you to get a nicely subtle two-stage phase effect by itself.

The Halo has a truly beautiful sound in stereo, but it may or may not be what you're looking for in a chorus pedal. Like all other Diamond products, it's built with the utmost care and attention to detail. Component quality is second to none, the noise floor is low, and the available headroom is high. It should be noted that it runs on 18 to 24 volts DC, with a current draw of 95 mA. The MDV2 is gone now, but I still own the Diamond Vibrato, Memory Lane 2, and StMix. Diamond is topnotch gear in my book, but only you will be able to tell if the Halo sound is what you're looking for.
