A button visible from both the rear and top panel accesses Playback mode. In all Record modes, the DSCH5 provides an onscreen LCD menu activated by the Menu button, with a variety of options for adjusting image quality or adding special effects. An optional Function Guide displays short help

information. The four arrows of the arrow pad are used to scroll through menu options, while the button in the center of the pad confirms selections. When in Record mode, the arrows adjust flash settings, Macro mode, the selftimer, and exposure compensation. In Aperture, Shutter, or Manual modes, turning the Jog Dial on the front of the grip makes shutter, aperture, and EV adjustments, and pushing the dial in activates the selection after selecting it by spinning the dial. When in Manual mode, information on the LCD to the right of these values tells you by how many EV units it thinks your exposure is off, up to plus or minus 2 EV. The Zoom control in the top right corner of the back panel adjusts both optical and digital zoom when the latter is activated through the Setup menu. Sony was indeed efficient with the H5 control layout, especially considering the large number of external controls and the large LCD, but my fingers seemed to find the wrong one at the wrong time all the time. It also warns when Super SteadyShot is off. Halfpressing the Shutter button causes the camera to display the shutter speed and aperture setting it has chosen for the current lighting conditions. Pressing the Display button once adds the exposure information and a small histogram to the overlay, pressing it again removes the information overlay entirely, and pressing it a third time returns to the default view. Pressing the wideangle side of the zoom lever takes you to a display showing images on the Memory Stick in groups of nine small thumbnails. You can navigate a yellow outline cursor over these thumbnails by using the four arrow keys.

Pressing the telephoto side of the zoom lever will bring the currently selected image up fullscreen. Pressing the telephoto side of the zoom lever when viewing an image fullsize on the LCD screen will zoom in on the image, in 17 variable sized increments up to a maximum magnification of 5x. Seven Scene modes are available, including High Sensitivity, Twilight, Twilight Portrait, Beach, Highspeed shutter, Landscape, and Portrait. High Sensitivity mode raises the camera's ISO setting to 1,000, while enabling a noise reduction setting to reduce the effect of image noise. Both Twilight modes capture images in low light, although the Twilight Portrait mode automatically enables the RedEye Reduction flash mode, combining it with a slower shutter speed to let ambient lighting brighten the background as well. Because the camera employs a slower shutter speed in both Twilight modes, a tripod is highly recommended to prevent blurring from camera movement. Beach mode optimizes the camera for bright situations and prevents color loss from overexposure. High Speed Shutter mode biases the shutter speed to better capture action. Landscape mode sets the focus at infinity and uses a smaller lens aperture to capture sharp details both near and far away. Portrait mode biases exposure toward wider apertures for sharp subjects isolated against a blurred background. In this mode, you can scroll through captured images, delete them, writeprotect them, and set them up for printing on PictBridge compatible printers. You can also copy, resize, and rotate images. In Movie mode, you can record moving images and sound, for as long as the Memory Stick or internal memory has space. Resolution and quality choices are 640 x 480 Fine 30 fps, 640 x 480 Normal 17 fps, or 160 x 112 8 fps. Recording in 640 x 480 Fine 30 fps mode is only available with a Memory Stick Duo Pro card.

Multi Burst shots are played back as a slow motion animation on the camera, but appear as a single large file with 16 subimages in it when viewed on a computer. A Burst mode is also available, and captures a rapid series of images for as long as the Shutter button is held down. Frame rates and the maximum number of images depends on the image quality and resolution settings, as well as the amount of available memory space. Spot metering reads the exposure from the very center of the frame identified by a cross hair target on the monitor. Spot metering is handy for backlit subjects, or any time the subject and background have very different brightness levels. CenterWeighted also reads from the center of the frame, but from a larger area than Spot. MultiMetering mode reads the entire frame to determine exposure. Smart Zoom restricts the digital zoom range to that which can be achieved without interpolating the image data. No Smart Zoom is available at the full sixmegapixel resolution, progressively more is available as you reduce the image size.

Precision Zoom interpolates the image as needed to fill the currently selected pixel dimensions with the subject. If set to Auto, the light automatically illuminates in dark shooting conditions to help the camera focus. Front curtain sync fires the flash at the beginning of the exposure, while rear curtain sync fires at the end. Shooting mode activates SteadyShot only when shutter is pressed. Continuous mode leaves the SteadyShot active at all times, which results in increased battery consumption, but may make it easier to see whats going on in the viewfinder at long telephoto settings. The huge zoom range is great for occasions when you want versatility but dont want to lug around a DSLR and a ton of lenses. A testament to the freedom that digital photography has brought to camera designers, the Sony Cyber Shot DSCH5 shares the lopsided look of its Hseries brethren, the DSCH2 and DSCH1.

Its big zoom lens dominates the left side, while a prominent, wellcontoured grip defines the cameras righthand side. High up the front of the grip is a control wheel to change manual exposure settings. Just above that sits the shutterrelease button, angled slightly forward. Just to the left of the mode dial are the power button and a button for image stabilization Super SteadyShot, in Sony parlance. Just behind these buttons, leaning toward the back of the camera, are two more buttons; one switches between the LCD and the electronic viewfinder EVF, the other lets you enter and exit playback mode. Below the rocker is the trash button, while menu and display buttons are tucked between the zoom and menu controls. While there doesnt seem to be another logical place for the menu control, I accidentally activated it a number of times while shooting. Other than that, the controls are well placed and accessible, and Sonys menu system is easy to navigate. Conveniently, Sony built a hinged cover for the compartment, so you dont have to worry about the batteries falling out when changing the memory card, though the stubbyfingered among us may struggle a bit to remove the small Memory Stick Duo. This bit of fancy design also means you probably wont have to remove the camera from your tripod if you fill up the card while snapping twilight shots of Times Square. Some may complain that 36mm isnt wide enough, but the vast majority of users will love the enormous reach at the telephoto end. An SLR lens with these specs would cost at least as much and probably more than this entire camera. Plus, this camera includes Sonys Super SteadyShot image stabilization, which increases the effectiveness of the lens wide maximum apertures in lowlight situations. Sure, this isnt very different than the digital zoom built into most cameras, but the simple translation into lower megapixels makes the feature much more useful.

Snapshooters will appreciate the cameras simple auto mode and handful of scene modes, while more advanced users will be happy to see the DSCH5s full manual exposure controls, including aperture priority, shutter priority, program, and full manual. The DSCH5s movie mode tops out at 640x480 pixels and 30fps, and it produces goodlooking clips, but if you plan on using this highest video setting, youll need a Memory Stick Pro Duo card. If not, youll have to settle for 16.6fps or a lower resolution. Thankfully, the prices for Pro Duo media have come down in recent months. Autofocus lagged a bit while panning in video mode, but for a still camera, it did surprisingly well, and its video email setting makes it a snap to create small clips to send to your friends. Sony includes a pair of 2,100mAh nickelmetalhydride rechargeable AAs to power the camera, along with a small charger, though standard batteries will do the trick in a pinch. The camera also comes with a lens hood, a cap, and an adapter ring that lets you use accessories, such as conversion lenses, filters, and even a ring light. Persnickety purchasers will note that the DSCH5 doesnt include a hotshoe, so youll have to live with the builtin flash. While by no means slow, the Sony Cyber Shot DSCH5 lagged a little behind the Cyber Shot DSCH2 in most cases.
